Dear Resident or Property Owner:

San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E®) highest priority is providing you with safe and reliable natural gas and electric service. As part of our commitment to you, we periodically need to make improvements to our facilities within your community to enhance system reliability.

You may have received previous notices regarding this project. This second notice is to inform you of construction activities in the vicinity of SDG&E's existing Del Mar Substation immediately northwest of the intersection of Interstate 5 and Via De La Valle, and east along Via De La Valle approximately 1.1 miles to the intersection of El Camino Real in San Diego. Construction activities include installing a new one-mile section of 69 kilovolt underground transmission line within Villa De La Valle, and installing new cable poles on either end. Additional notices will be mailed upon issuance of Caltrans permits.

As part of this project, temporary construction support sites will be required along the alignment. These sites will serve as temporary storage for materials and equipment and will be used for parking during construction hours. These temporary sites will be restored to their original condition and use upon completion of the project.

Construction will take place in phases and is scheduled to begin on or near May 17, 2021. Construction work will generally take place Monday through Saturday between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. unless otherwise directed by local traffic control permits. Some night work is anticipated and temporary lane closures are expected.

Traffic delays and temporary lane closures are expected. We plan to have traffic control measures in place during construction, and our crews will strive to minimize any impacts to you and your neighbors. We encourage you to adjust commuting plans as necessary.

Construction dates are subject to change according to compliance requirements, inclement weather, or other unforeseen circumstances. We'll provide additional updates should construction dates change.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience you may experience during construction activities. SDG&E will continue to work closely with local municipalities and community groups to ensure construction activities are as least disruptive as possible. We also plan to keep communities informed during all phases of the project's construction. We're committed to working with you and local public safety officials to help minimize inconveniences and safeguard a smooth construction process.

During this COVID-19 outbreak, we ask for your support in helping us maintain a healthy work environment for our employees, contractors and community. We ask customers not to approach or interact with our field crews. Please maintain a distance of 6 feet as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). We ask that customers adhere to any posted construction and parking notifications. We want to maintain healthy business operations during challenging times like these, and continue safely providing essential services like electricity and natural gas. We appreciate our customers' understanding.
