Dear Resident or Property Owner:

San Diego Gas and Electric (SDG&E®) will begin construction on the Streamview Substation Rebuild and Expansion Project to ensure the continued safety and reliability of the local electric grid and accommodate future load growth in the College area. By expanding and reconfiguring the existing Streamview Substation's aging electric service equipment, SDG&E will be able to better meet current engineering standards and improve reliability. These enhancements will enable SDG&E to better serve customers in the area and minimize the potential for long-term unplanned outages or service disruptions to residents and businesses.

SDG&E will begin construction, which includes upgrading the existing 12kV distribution lines at the substation, on November 28. The work at this location will be performed in three phases. The construction activities will take place along 54<sup>th</sup> Street from Chollas Parkway until just before University Avenue for about ¼ mile, and on Lea Avenue from 54<sup>th</sup> Street east for approximately 500 feet.

The first phase of work will include trenching and excavation to accommodate for the reconfiguration of existing overhead and underground 12kV distribution lines. Once this phase is complete, Phases 2 & 3 will begin, with the addition of three new distribution lines to the substation. This will provide additional capacity to meet current standards and also accommodate future customer load growth.

Most of the construction activity will take place in the street and sidewalks surrounding the SDG&E-owned substation property. Once construction work is complete, SDG&E will restore the area to its original state.

Noise and dust disturbances may increase due to construction activities. We will keep communities informed during all phases of the project.
