Dear Resident or Property Owner:

As you are aware, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E®) completed a large portion of the electric undergrounding work along San Dieguito Drive in April as part of the Del Mar Reconfiguration Project. This Phase 2 work included trenching along San Dieguito Drive to prepare for the undergrounding of the existing overhead circuit.

For approximately three weeks starting July 10, SDG&E crews will be installing the new underground cable along San Dieguito Drive and Racetrack View Drive. As the trench has already been completed and underground vaults installed in April, crews will use equipment to pull the cable through the underground alignment.

Traffic delays and temporary lane closures are expected. We plan to have traffic control measures in place during construction, and our crews will strive to minimize any impacts to you and your neighbors. We encourage you to adjust commuting plans as necessary.

Work activities include cable pulling and splicing within the underground alignment and support activities. Phase 3 of the project will begin in the fall of 2023 and will include the removal of 35 transmission poles and circuit from Del Mar to Sorrento Valley. That work will take place in September.

We apologize for any inconvenience you may experience during construction activities and appreciate the community's support as we complete this important project. SDG&E will continue to work closely with local municipalities and community groups to ensure construction activities are as least disruptive as possible. We also plan to keep communities informed during all phases of the Project's construction. We're committed to working with you and local public safety officials to help minimize inconveniences and safeguard a smooth construction process.
