6	The purpose of my testimony is to present the electric sales forecasts used in San			
7	Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E's) Test Year 2008 General Rate Case (GRC).			
8	II. FORECAST OF ELECTRIC SALES			
9	This chapter sets forth the estimated levels of SDG&E sales for 2008. The annual			
10	projection of total electric sales is 20,652 gigawatt hours (gWh). Details are presented in			
11	Table 1 of this testimony.			
12	III. FORECAST BACKGROUND			
13	The forecast of electric sales presented in this proceeding is consistent with			
14	SDG&E's Long-Term Procurement Plan (LTPP). The California Public Utilities			
15	Commission (Commission), in its LTPP Assigned Commissioner Ruling and Scoping			
16	Memo, dated September 25, 2006 (Rulemaking 06-02-013) requires that the forecast			
17	developed by the California Energy Commission (CEC) be used in the LTPP process.			
18	SDG&E finds the CEC's forecast of 2008 electric sales to be reasonable and is therefore			
19	using that forecast in this GRC.
