PROGRAM OVERVIEW

To meet customer demand for more electric vehicle (EV) chargers in the region, San Diego Gas & Electric® (SDG&E®) plans to install charging infrastructure at about 100 workplace locations. Among the sites selected, 50% will support underserved communities and small businesses.

WHAT IS AN “UNDERSERVED COMMUNITY (USC)”

An underserved community is a community that meets one or more criteria defined by California Assembly Bill 841, which includes certain disadvantaged areas and federally recognized tribal communities and small businesses.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Own or lease the property where chargers are installed and can attest to using the site for 5 years
- Must own and maintain the EV chargers
- An easement may be required

CHARGER REBATES

The program offers a one-time rebate for both single and dual port chargers. You can select from a variety of EV charger options from our approved vendor list.

Equipment Type	Equipment Rebate
L2 Charger in USC and/or small business	100% of charger cost up to \$2,000
L2 Charger not in USC or non-small business	50% of charger cost up to \$2,000

INFRASTRUCTURE INSTALLATION OPTIONS

The Power Your Drive program offers construction and maintenance incentives, depending on the location of your site:

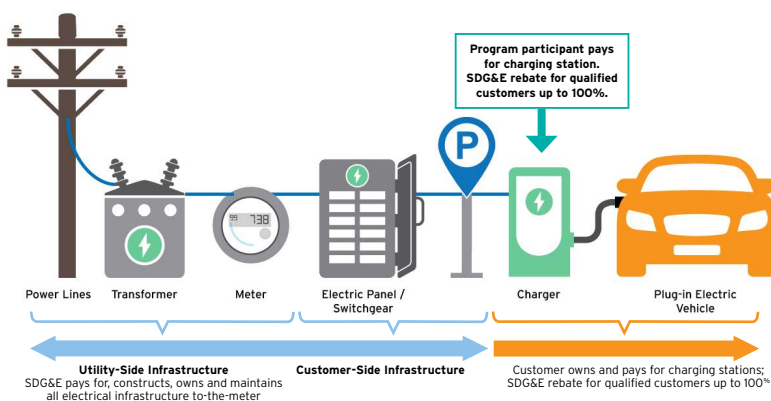
OPTION 1:

SDG&E-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers

- SDG&E pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains all infrastructure up to the charging station
- Customer pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains charging station
- SDG&E provides a rebate for the cost of the charging station. See Charger Rebates section for more details.
- An easement is required

1) SDG&E-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers

SDG&E pays for a significant portion of the costs



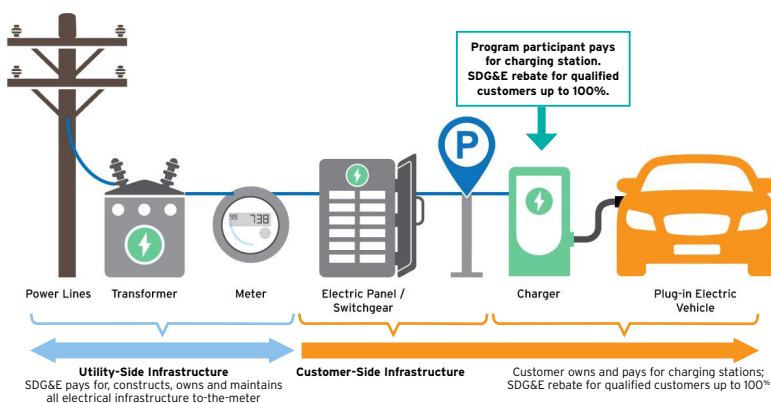
OPTION 2:

Customer-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers

- SDG&E pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains all infrastructure up to the meter.
- Customer pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains "customer-side infrastructure" and charging stations.
- SDG&E provides a rebate of up to 100% of the cost of "customer-side infrastructure."
- SDG&E provides a rebate for the cost of the charging station. See Charger Rebates section for more details.

2) Customer-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers

SDG&E pays for infrastructure cost up to the customer meter
