



MIP can fund

- Up to \$14M per community microgrid for management, engineering and development costs, such as in front-of-the-meter batteries and clean generation resources
- Up to a \$1M allowance for interconnection related costs
- Up to a \$3M allowance for microgrid special facilities related costs

Microgrid Incentive Program

California's investor-owned utilities (Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas and Electric®, and Southern California Edison) are leading the nation by launching a program to provide clean, local energy to communities that need it most.

The Microgrid Incentive Program (MIP) is a competitive grant program providing \$200M in funding to communities facing outages, power shutoffs and other events driven by climate change.

- Advance climate resiliency technology
- Provide reliable energy to disadvantaged populations
- Inform future clean energy initiatives
