We are following up on a notification letter previously mailed to you on January 18, 2024, to let you know that San Diego Gas & Electric® Company (SDG&E®) or its Contractors will be in your area working on the Santee Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) project. You will see an increase in activity at the project site as crews begin to mobilize and start the primary construction and installation work.

<u>Santee BESS Project (Santee Substation) Updated Details*:</u>

Anticipated Schedule: Ongoing through approximately Q1 2025.

Location: On SDG&E's Santee Substation property located off Mast Blvd, near Magnolia

Avenue, Santee, CA.

Workdays and Hours: Monday – Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.; with the potential for

extended work hours.

No Service Interruption: Your service should continue without interruption.

*NOTE: Construction dates and hours are subject to change according to compliance requirements, inclement weather and other unforeseen circumstances. Construction work hours, traffic control measures, and noise restrictions are established by local jurisdictions.

The Santee BESS project is a 10MW battery that will enhance the state-wide electric grid, providing a system-wide benefit to the San Diego region. This project is part of SDG&E's commitment to sustainability and to provide safe, clean, and reliable energy, by integrating a growing number of energy storage projects to help maximize the use of renewable electricity produced by the sun and wind and support grid reliability.

SDG&E will work to minimize impacts from construction activities to the extent feasible. Noise and dust disturbances may increase due to construction activities. We apologize for any inconvenience you may experience during construction activities, and we appreciate the community's continued patience and support as we work to complete this important project.
