In Attachment D. Illustrative Proposed Rates (energy) time-of-use periods are listed as "On Peak," "Semi-Peak" and "Off-Peak." Is "Semi-Peak" the same as the new "Off peak" and "Off-Peak" the same as the new "Super-off Peak" periods in SDG&E's proposed new TOU costing periods? If not, please provide "Illustrative Proposed Rates" for Attachment H (Illustrative Year 3 rates) with the new TOU period Peak, Off Peak, and Super-Off peak for rates: TOU-A, Small Commercial New Option, A-TOU, AL-TOU, M/L C&I New Option, DG-R, A6-TOU, PA-T-1, and TOU-PA.

SDG&E Response:

Yes, the assumption stated above is correct. SDG&E's current TOU periods for Schedules TOU-A (the Small Commercial Greater Fixed Charge Option), AL-TOU (the M/L C&I Option), DG-R, A6-TOU, PAT-1 and TOU-PA all reflect On-Peak, Semi-Peak and Off-Peak time periods. As presented in the Direct Testimony of Cynthia Fang, SDG&E's Time-Of-Use period proposal is:

- On-Peak time period of 4pm-9pm daily
- Super-Off Peak time period of 12am-6am weekdays and 12am-2pm weekends/holidays
- Off Peak time period of all other hours

In presenting Attachments D, F and H in the Direct Testimony of Christopher Swartz, SDG&E presented the rates using the proposed time periods and mapped them to the current TOU period descriptions. In these Attachments, the "On-Peak" description reflects the proposed rates for the "On-Peak" time period. The "Semi-Peak" description reflects the proposed rates for the "Off-Peak" time period. The "Off-Peak" description reflects the proposed "Super-Off" time period.
