PROGRAM OVERVIEW

To meet customer demand for more electric vehicle (EV) chargers in the region, San Diego Gas & Electric® (SDG&E®) plans to install charging infrastructure at about 100 locations over two years. These chargers will be installed at or near apartments and condominium complexes. Among the sites selected, 50% will support underserved communities.

WHAT IS AN "UNDERSERVED COMMUNITY (USC)"

An underserved community is a community that meets one or more criteria defined by California Assembly Bill 841, which includes certain disadvantaged areas and federally recognized tribal communities.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Own or lease the property where chargers are installed and can attest to using the site for 5 years
- If your location is outside of a USC, you must own and maintain the EV chargers
- If your location is inside a USC:
 - Site hosts have the option to have SDG&E own and maintain the charger (easement required)
 - Charging infrastructure may be placed within 0.5 miles of the apartment or condo in a space where both sites will benefit from the EV charger installations. (i.e., community centers, shopping centers, libraries, movie theaters, etc.)
- · An easement may be required

CHARGER REBATES

The program offers a one-time rebate for both single and dual port chargers, network service and maintenance. You can select from a variety of EV charger options from our approved vendor list. The one-time rebate is not applicable for SDG&E-owned and maintained chargers.

INFRASTRUCTURE INSTALLATION OPTIONS

The Power Your Drive program offers construction and maintenance incentives, depending on the location of your site:

OPTION 1:

SDG&E-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers

- SDG&E pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains all infrastructure up to the charging station
- Customer pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains charging station
- SDG&E provides a rebate of up to 100% of the cost of the charging station. See Charger Rebates section for more details.
- An easement is required

OPTION 2:

Customer-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers

- SDG&E pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains all infrastructure up to the meter.
- Customer pays for, constructs, owns, and maintains "customer-side infrastructure" and charging stations.
- SDG&E provides a rebate of up to 100% of the cost of "customer-side infrastructure."
- SDG&E provides a rebate of up to 100% of the cost of the charging station. See Charger Rebates section for more details.

OPTION 3:

SDG&E-Owned Infrastructure, SDG&E-Owned Chargers

(Available only to sites in underserved communities)


- SDG&E will pay for, construct, own, and maintain all infrastructure, including the charging station(s).
- · An easement is required




DID YOU KNOW?


1) SDG&E-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers SDG&E pays for a significant portion of the costs



2) Customer-Owned Infrastructure, Customer-Owned Chargers SDG&E pays for Infrastructure cost up to the customer meter



3) SDG&E-Owned Infrastructure, SDG&E-Owned Chargers SDG&E pays for the total costs. Available only to sites in USCs.
