


- SDG&E to install charging infrastructure for minimum 3,000 MD/HD on-road and off-road EVs (Class 2-8)
- 5-year program; \$107M; final Decision August 23, 2019
- Make-ready charging infrastructure program
 - "To-the-meter" (SDG&E)
 - "Behind-the-meter" (customer-choice)

- Charging station rebates for qualified customers:
 - Disadvantaged Communities




Option 1: SDG&E-Owned

SDG&E pays for a significant portion of the total costs



Option 2: Customer-Owned


SDG&E pays for infrastructure cost up to the customer meter


Vehicle-to-Grid ("V2G") School Bus Pilot



Proposed Pilot Design:


- Ten electric school buses at one school
- SDG&E installs, owns, and maintains the V2G chargers
- Buses operate normally, but during down time buses charge and discharge to optimize total cost of ownership

Multi-year pilot with data collection analysis performed by SDG&E









"Clean Air for All"

Carl Moyer Program (regional focus)

- Fleet turnover for cost-effective, near-term SIP reductions
- Trucks, buses, utility vehicles, construction, agriculture, marine vessels, cargo handling, infrastructure

Community Air Protection Program (AB617) (community focus)

- Investments in most burdened communities
- Priority on community needs and input
- Stationary sources eligible

Voucher Incentive Program (VIP)

- Trucks, buses, fleets of 10 or less
- Diesel replacements
- Must already be compliant

Prop 1B Goods Movement (GMERP)

- PM & NOx reductions in goods movement corridors
- Trucks, cargo handling, TRUs
- Leftover funds will be available soon

 Pollution Control District (APCD)

MD/HD Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Incentives



CA Utility Programs

- Charging infrastructure service upgrades and electricity rates
- ~\$700M
- SDG&E's MD/HD program accounts for ~\$107M

Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS)

 Credits for using low carbon transportation fuels



Electric Vehicle High Power (EV-HP) Charging Rate





 A new rate for DC Fast Charging and Medium Duty/Heavy Duty EV charging

Pending Application

- Filed application with the CPUC July 2019 (A.19-07-006)
- EV-HP rate is expected to simplify and increase the competitiveness of charging for many DCFC and MD/HD EV customers

Monthly Subscription Charge

Customer subscribes to desired power level – lower power, lower subscription charge.

A declining ten-year discount encourages customers to adopt electric vehicles sooner.

Time-of-Use Energy Charge

Customers save money by avoiding charging between 4 – 9pm.

MD/HD Preliminary Eligibility Requirements



- ✓ Must procure at least 2 EVs
- √ Submit vehicle acquisition plan
- ✓ Agree to enroll on an eligible TOU rate
- ✓ Provide proof of purchase (chargers & vehicles)
- ✓ Operate & maintain charging equipment for at least 10 years
- ✓ Must provide charging data for at least 5 years after charger is installed
- ✓ Must submit a Load Management Plan





MD/HD Preliminary Eligibility Requirements



- Own or lease property where chargers to be installed or be the customer of record associated with the meter
- ✓ Be an SDG&E customer (this includes Direct Access & CCA customers)
- ✓ Site must include an appropriate location to deploy charging equipment in a cost-effective manner
- ✓ Provide a signed land rights document (i.e. easement) by the site owner
- ✓ Agree to program terms & conditions
- Procure EV charging station from approved vendor list







Goals - Disadvantaged Communities (DAC)

- Top 25% most burdened/vulnerable census tracts from a statewide perspective.
- GHG emissions reductions in the areas most impacted by poor air quality within our region and throughout the state.
- ≤ 50% rebate for the charger
- ~5% of SDG&E's territory
- Statewide DAC = Blue
