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1 **PREPARED SUPPLEMENTAL TESTIMONY OF**
2 **KHOANG T. NGO RE SOLAR ON MUTLIFAMILY AFFORADABLE HOUSING**
3 **PROGRAM FUNDING ON BEHALF OF SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY**

4 **I. INTRODUCTION**

5 The purpose of my supplemental testimony is to address cost recovery related to funding
6 for the Disadvantaged Communities Single Family Solar Homes program (“DAC-SASH”)
7 revenue requirement. More specifically, my supplemental testimony:

- 8 • Describes SDG&E’s Disadvantaged Communities Single Family Solar Homes
9 program Balancing Account (“DAC-SASHBA”); and,
- 10 • Sets forth SDG&E’s forecasted 2021 DAC-SASHBA revenue requirements

11 **II. DAC-SASHBA**

12 The purpose of the DAC-SASHBA is to balance allocated greenhouse gas (“GHG”)
13 allowance revenues and program costs. The DAC-SASH Balancing Account was established in
14 2019 in Commission Decision 18-06-027 and Advice Letter 3410-E. D.18-06-027 OP 8 states
15 that the DACSASH program will be funded with GHG allowance proceeds if available and
16 recovered through the Public Purpose Program (“PPP”) mechanism if GHG allowance proceeds
17 are unavailable.

18 In the 2021 ERRA Forecast Prepared Supplemental Testimony of SDG&E Witness
19 Stefan Covic, he states the total DAC-SASH program funding is estimated to be \$1.03 million.
20 The forecasted 2021 GHG allowance revenues available for clean energy and energy efficiency
21 programs as set forth in the Prepared Supplemental Testimony of Mr. Covic will not be sufficient
22 to cover the entire \$1.03 million after setting aside funding for the Solar on Multifamily
23 Affordable Housing (“SOMAH”) Program. As Mr. Covic states, the portion of the 2021 DAC-
24 SASH funding that cannot be funded from GHG allowance revenue in 2021 is estimated to be

1 \$0.593 million (\$0.600 million including FF&U). SDG&E accordingly requests authorization to
2 collect a revenue requirement of \$0.600 million through PPP rates for DAC-SASH funding.

3 **III. SUMMARY**

4 My supplemental testimony presents the following revenue requirement for which
5 SDG&E seeks recovery in this 2021 ERRRA Forecast Application:

- 6 • 2021 DAC-SASH revenue requirement of \$0.600 million to be recovered through
7 PPP rates.

8 Each of these amounts include FF&U.
