### NOTICE OF SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (U 902 E) SUPPLEMENTAL TESTIMONY RE SOLAR ON MULTIFAMILY AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM FUNDING

At the request of the California Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Energy Division ("ED"), San Diego Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E") is submitting the supplemental testimony of Stefan Covic, Stacy Fuhrer, and Khoang Ngo to update SDG&E's 2021 forecast of greenhouse gas ("GHG") allowance revenues set aside for the Solar on Multifamily Affordable Housing ("SOMAH") Program. At the time SDG&E filed its 2021 Energy Resource Recovery Account ("ERRA") Forecast Application on April 15, 2020, it was not able to include the SOMAH funding request as the Commission had not yet issued its decision for Rulemaking 14-07-002 and Application 16-07-015 extending the SOMAH program funding. On April 23, 2020, the Commission issued its Decision 20-04-012, which continues authorization of allocation of funds to the SOMAH program through June 30, 2026. In light of this Decision, ED has requested that SDG&E submit supplemental testimony to update its SOMAH funding request prior to its November Update to allow for additional time to review.

In addition to the supplemental testimony of Mr. Covic, Ms. Fuhrer and Ms. Ngo, SDG&E is also submitting an updated version of Attachment G (Template D-1 Only) GHG Revenue and Reconciliation Form to reflect the updated figures set forth in the supplemental testimony. Specifically, the 2021 forecast column of Template D-1 has been updated and an additional column has been added to clearly show the change compared to the figures submitted

in SDG&E's 2021 ERRA Forecast Application (See Updated Attachment G attached hereto.)

SDG&E will provide a complete update of Attachment G with its November Update.
