## What is SDG&E's Power Your Drive Program (PYD)?

To meet customer demand for more electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure in the region, San Diego Gas & Electric® (SDG&E®) has installed more than 3,000 EV chargers at 254 locations. These chargers were placed at apartments, condominium complexes and workplaces – locations where most charging takes place. Over 30 percent of the chargers installed are in communities of concern – areas that suffer from high levels of air pollution and tailpipe emissions due to their proximity to freeways or industrial facilities.

In order to install more chargers for the growing interest list of several hundred properties and organizations, SDG&E submitted a proposal to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to install 2,000 additional chargers at 200 locations over two years. These chargers would again be installed at apartments, condominium complexes and workplaces.

#### Why are these locations important?

Fifty percent of SDG&E's customers live in multi-unit communities. Without access to vehicle charging, there is virtually no way for these residents to ever become part of the solution to significantly reduce air pollution or to save money by fueling with electricity instead of gasoline. Power Your Drive helps address infrastructure gaps in the market and ensures charging is accessible to all.

- Drivers can set a max price of what they want to pay to charge their EV
- Customers charge on average with 78% renewable energy

#### The customer is in control

Power Your Drive offers a pricing plan that changes hourly to encourage drivers to charge during grid-friendly times. Participants can monitor the hourly rate and control how much they pay.

Power Your Drive participants pay, on average, around \$0.19 per kilowatt hour – that translates to paying around \$1.60 for a gallon of gas.
