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II. INTRODUCTION

This rebuttal testimony regarding San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E) request for Gas Transmission Operation¹ addresses the following testimony from other parties:

The Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) as submitted by Ms. Mariana C. Campbell (Exhibit ORA-09), dated April 13, 2018.²

Please note that the fact that I may not have responded to every issue raised by others in this rebuttal testimony, does not mean or imply that SDG&E agrees with the proposal or contention made by these or other parties. The forecasts contained in SDG&E's direct testimony, performed at the project level, are based on sound estimates of its revenue requirements at the time of testimony preparation.

My testimony addresses Gas Transmission Operations and Maintenance (O&M) expenses only at SDG&E and Gas Transmission (SDG&E-GT) capital forecasts are found in the joint direct and rebuttal testimony of SDG&E witnesses Michael Bermel and Beth Musich

(Exhibits SDG&E-07 and SDG&E-207, respectively). ORA submitted testimony addressing
 SDG&E Gas Transmission O&M expenses. ORA addressed operating and maintenance concerns
 with a single cost-specific recommendation, stating it does not dispute SDG&E's TY 2019
 expense forecast for Non-Shared Gas Transmission O&M expenses,³ and clarified that "ORA
 does not dispute SDG&E's TY 2019 expense forecast for activities within Gas Transmission
 Pipelines,⁴ Compressor Stations,⁵ and Technical Services.⁶

A. ORA

ORA issued its report on Gas Transmission Operation on April 13, 2018. The following is a summary of ORA's position(s):

• "ORA does not take issue with SDG&E's forecasts of Non-Shared Gas Transmission Operation O&M expenses."⁷

- IV. CONCLUSION

 To summarize, the TY 2019 forecast cost associated with the operation and maintenance
 of SDG&E's gas transmission system as presented in my testimony and defended within this
 rebuttal are reasonable and should be adopted by the Commission.
 As noted in this rebuttal, I recommend the TY 2019 forecast of \$5,110,000 for Non

 Shared Operating and Maintenance expenses.
 SDG&E Gas Transmission does not have and is not sponsoring any Shared Services
 Operating and Maintenance expenses.
 These costs are reasonable and in alignment with SDG&E's commitment toward
 sustaining safe and reliable service to customers while also striving to control operating expenses
 without compromising safety or regulatory compliance.
