II. INTRODUCTION

This rebuttal testimony regarding SDG&E establishing the reasonableness of costs incurred for its Mobilehome Park Utility Upgrade Program (MHP Program) addresses the testimony of the Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) as submitted by Mr. Lambert (Exhibit ORA-32), dated April 13, 2018.¹
